**SECTION 4. FIRST AID MEASURES**

General advice

**SECTION 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES**

- Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures : Use personal protective equipment.

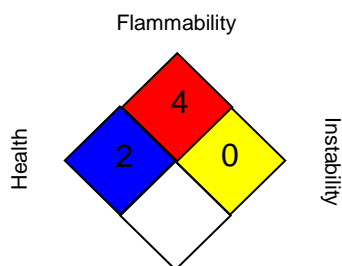
